PILCHUCK CAMERA CLUB April 8, 2010

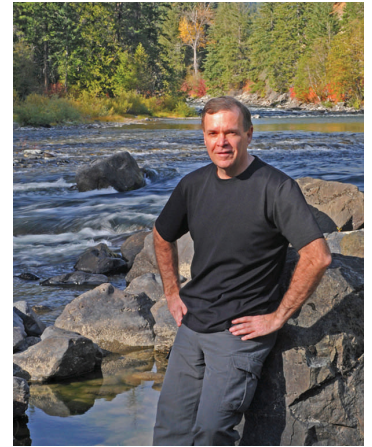
The regular meeting of the Pilchuck Camera Club was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by President Steve Lightle. Twelve members guests were present.
