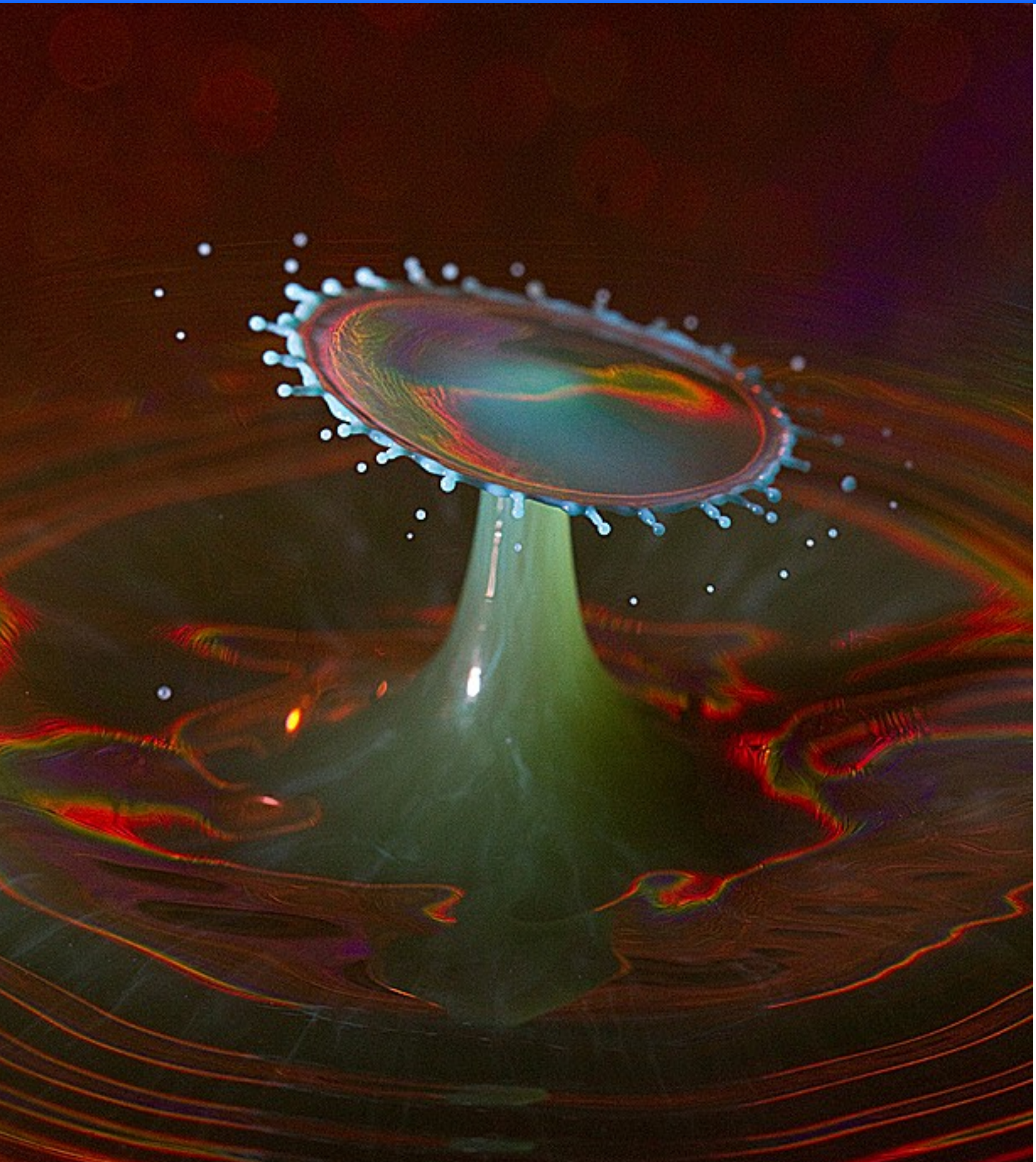

Old business: None

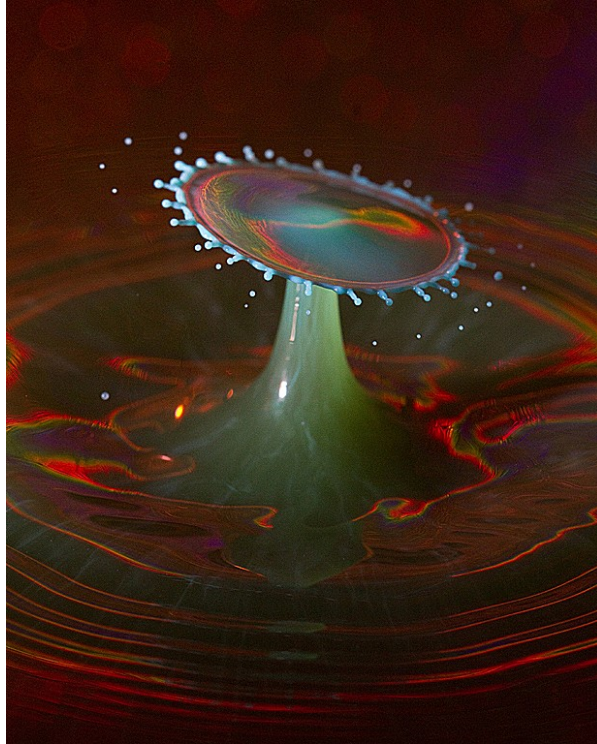

WATER COLLISION # 2
BY JIM BASINGER

This image was taken in my garage using a machine called a stopshot. The machine will operate a water valve with amount of time you want each drop to form and how long between drops. Drop falls thru a sensor and you set the time delay for the flash to fire. Camera is set on Bulb and turned off when flash fires. You can increase or decrease the delay of the flash by 1/10 of a microsecond . I have 3 flashes which fire at the same time with a remote hooked to the stopshot. 2 flashes are aimed at a colorful background and one at the water drop. Each flash is set to 1/128 power . The short duration of the flash is what freezes the drop. I have not done it yet but I can hook the camera to the stopshot and it will eliminate me having to operate the camera.

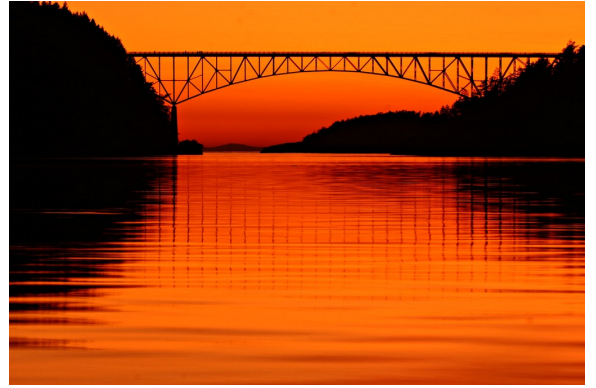
The machine can also be hooked to a microphone to get pictures of things like balloons busting,

The machine will be set up at our indoor workshop in January.

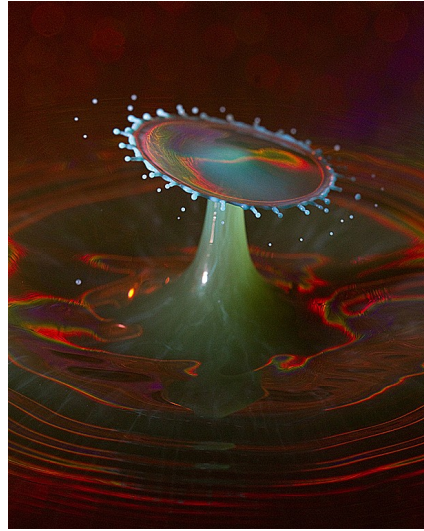

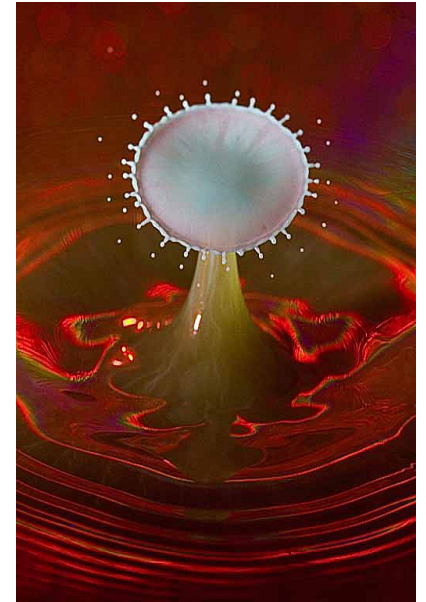

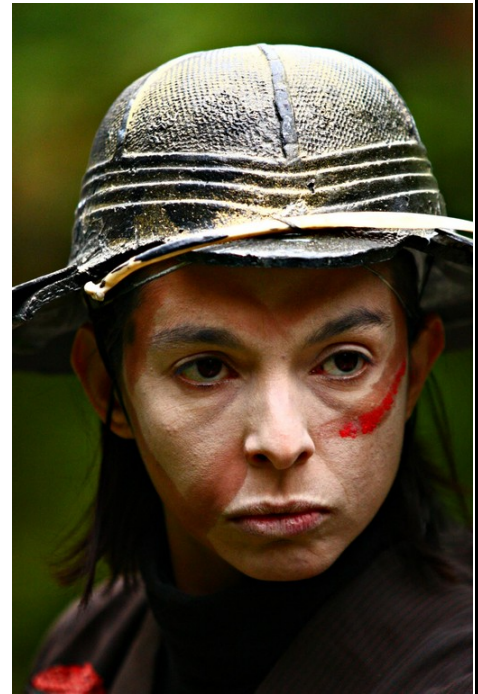
Butoh is the collective name for a diverse range of activities, techniques and motivations for dance, performance, or movement inspired by the Ankoku-Butoh movement. It typically involves playful and grotesque imagery, taboo topics, extreme or absurd environments, and is traditionally performed in white body makeup with slow hyper-controlled motion, with or without an audience. There is no set style, and it may be purely conceptual with no movement at all. Its origins have been attributed to Japanese dance legends Tatsumi Hijikata and Kazuo Ohno.
