Heron in Low Key - ISO 1250, 1/640 sec. 400mm

This guy has the lowdown on free fish! You can find him quite often waiting with the penguins at WPZ at feeding time. I had pretty even light on the heron and there was a light wind which caused the feathers to splay out which is what drew my attention to him. I had a pretty good non intrusive background of green tree but I didn't find to showcase the shapes and lines of the bird to my liking so, I used NIK Silver Effects Pro - low key filter and managed to get a look I liked. The background still had textures so I used a layer mask to just grab the background and used levels to pull down the back ground exposure to my liking which is almost totally black. A light brush around the edges of the bird to get rid of hard edges and this is what I got!
