Up up and away with Jerry Sorenson and a two seater airplane. We flew over the tulip fields. It was a joy to see the fields from above.

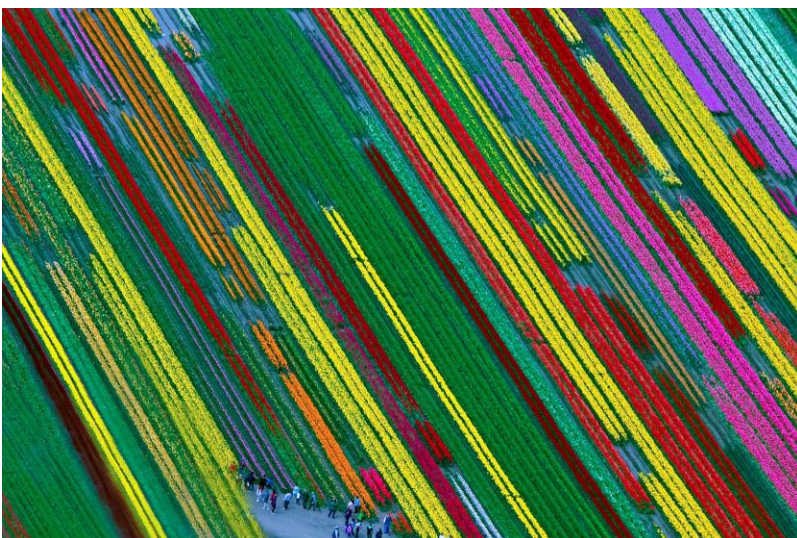

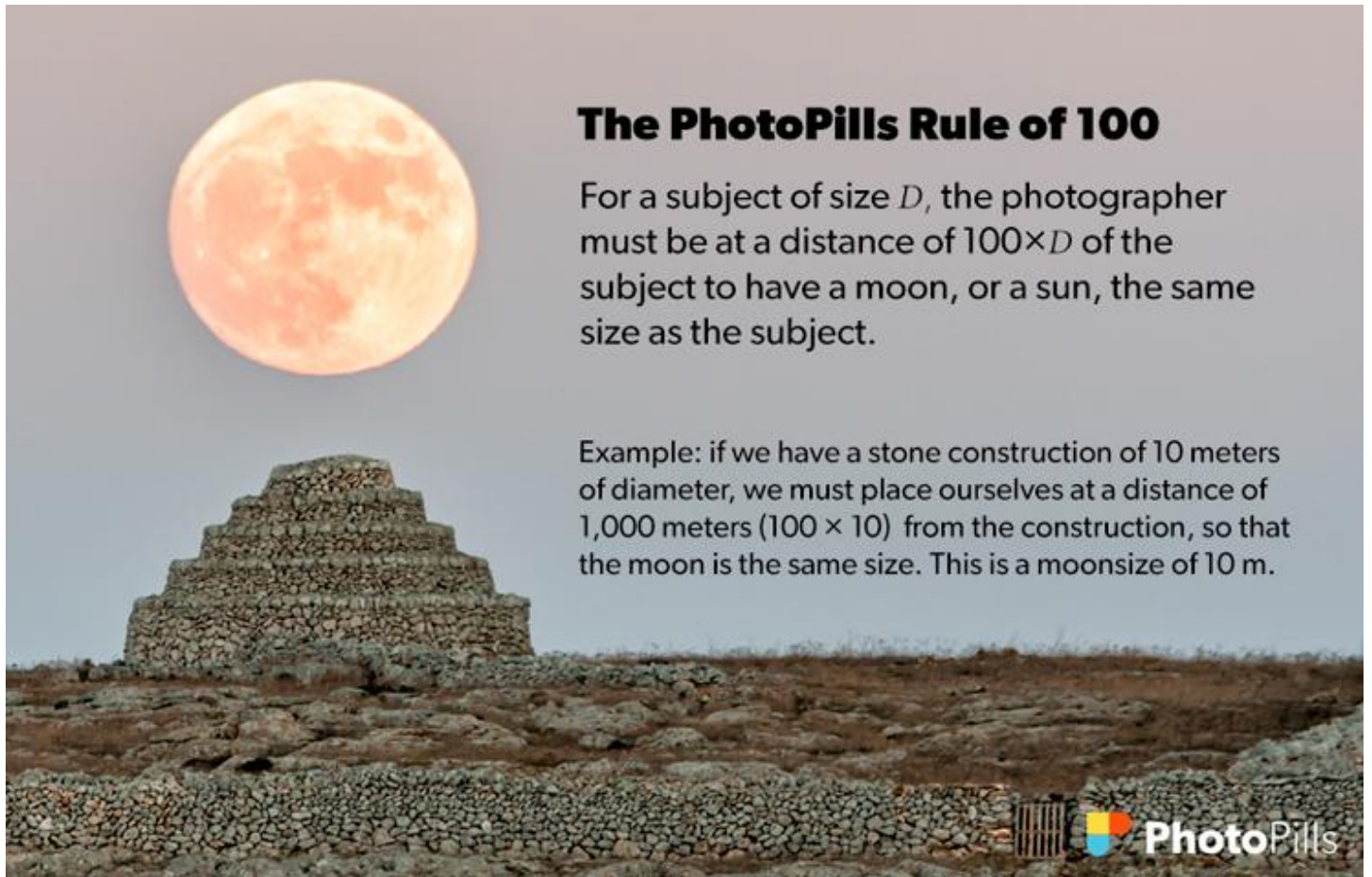

Moon Photography Tip

The PhotoPills Rule of 100

For a subject of size D , the photographer must be at a distance of $100 \times D$ of the subject to have a moon, or a sun, the same size as the subject.

Example: if we have a stone construction of 10 meters of diameter, we must place ourselves at a distance of 1,000 meters (100×10) from the construction, so that the moon is the same size. This is a moonsize of 10 m.

Note that focal length does not impact the formula. Focal length will be used in determining how you want the final image 'cropped'.

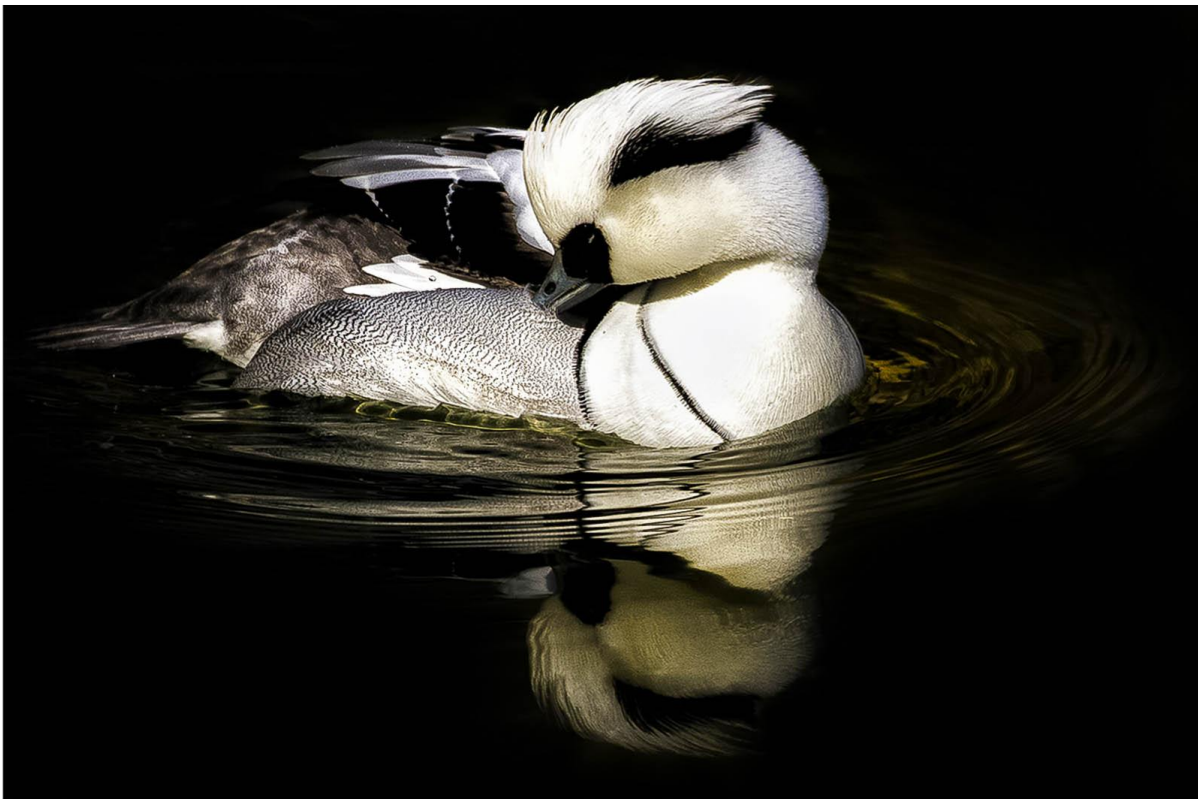

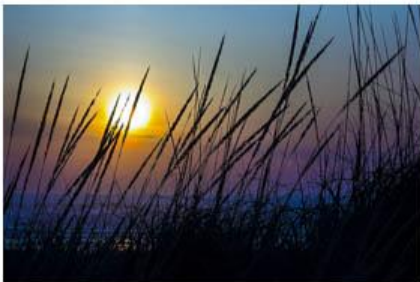

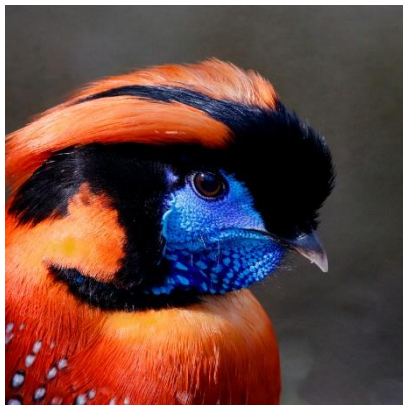
