Duties of the Officers The official duties of the officers are contained in the club Constitution and By-Laws.

PSA Guidelines

All PSA submissions can be taken at any time and must be owned by the submitter. Submit with the same sizing considerations as other PCC contests. Only one image per maker per contest can be sent to PSA with a maximum of 6 images for the club.

Travel

A Photo Travel image expresses the characteristic features or culture of a land as they are found naturally. There are no geographic limitations. Not allowed: Hired subjects, activities arranged specifically for photography, adding, relocating, replacing or removing any element of the original image, except by cropping

The only allowable adjustments are removal of dust or digital noise, restoration of the appearance of the original scene and complete conversion to grayscale monochrome. Other derivations, including infrared, are not permitted. All images must look natural.

Nature

Nature photography records all branches of natural history except anthropology and archaeology. This includes all aspects of the physical world, both animate and inanimate, that have not been made or modified by humans (i.e. no hand of man). Nature images must convey the truth of the scene that was photographed.

Allowed

- Objects created by humans, and evidence of human activity, are allowed in Nature images only when they are a necessary part of the Nature story
- Images taken with subjects under controlled conditions, such as zoos
- Cropping
- Techniques that remove elements added by the camera, such as dust spots, digital noise and lens flare
- Complete conversion of color images to grayscale monochrome
- Focus stacking
- Multiple images with overlapping fields of view that are taken consecutively and combined in-camera or with software (image stitching)

Not Allowed

- Unethical practices have been used to control the subject or capture the image
- Images that directly or indirectly show any human activity that threatens the life or welfare of a living organism
- Adding a vignette or blurring the background during processing
- Photographs of human-created hybrid plants, cultivated plants, feral animals, domesticated animals, humancreated hybrid animals and mounted or preserved zoological specimens
- Controlling live subjects by chilling, anesthetic or any other method of restricting natural movement for the purpose of a photograph
- Techniques that removes, adds or moves any part of the image
- Partial conversion, toning and infrared captures or conversions






